# **WILDERNESS AND REMOTE FIRST AID**

## **Boy Scouts of America**

### **High Adventure Training Teams**

The Boy Scouts of America have teamed up with the American Red Cross and the Emergency Care & Safety Institute to provide registered leaders and Scouts 14 and older, with the training necessary for them to participate in safe outings and fulfill the required training for certain events.

Your local Council's High Adventure Training Teams offer this 16-hour+ course at various times and locations. Please check with your HAT Teams' web site or follow the links to them on, [www.highadventureawards.com](http://www.highadventureawards.com). You may also check your Council/District training schedule.

This course is open to any individual 14 years of age or older. The only difference is that an individual who is not registered with the Boy Scouts of America, are required to take and pass a written test at the end of the course.

A requirement for completion of this course is that the student has completed a CPR course. If any students do not have this requirement, the Instructor(s) will offer this training at an alternate time or direct you to an instructor/facility to fulfill this requirement.

At the present time, BSA recommends (soon to require), units who participate in outings that are 60 minutes or longer from EMS, to have at least one participant trained in Wilderness and Remote First Aid. Additionally, participants who attend Philmont Scout Ranch and other BSA High Adventure Bases are required to have a leader who has completed Wilderness and Remote First Aid.

The course certificate is good for 2 years.

As for the rest of the members in your unit.

1. Have your leaders complete a First Aid/CPR/AED course.
2. Have your Scouts complete a First Aid/CPR/AED course.
  - a) Most first Aid Instructors will accept Scouts who are at least 12 years of age.
3. Have your Scouts earn the First Aid Merit Badge.
